WHAT TRAVELS WITH YOUR ORDER

Every lot of seed potatoes is independently inspected and certified by **NAK**, the Dutch General Inspection Service for agricultural seeds and seed potatoes. The certificate guarantees that the seed is healthy and true to variety, and meets the standards of the Dutch seed potato industry.

Each shipment travels with the NAK certificate and the **phytosanitary certificate** required by the destination country. Packing list, invoice and transport documents are arranged per order.
